6 For an Act entitled: "An Act changing the dates of certain legal holidays;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

10 Sec. 44.12.010. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are legal
11 holidays: (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day; (2) the
12 12th of February, known as Lincoln's Birthday; (3) the third Monday
13 in February, known as Washington's Birthday; (4) the last Monday of
14 March, known as Seward's Day; (5) the last Monday in May, known as
15 Memorial Day; (6) the fourth of July, known as Independence Day;
16 (7) the first Monday in September, known as Labor Day; (8) the third
17 Monday of October, known as Alaska Day; (9) the fourth Monday in
18 October, known as Veterans' Day; (10) the fourth Thursday in November,
19 known as Thanksgiving Day; (11) the 25th of December, known as Christmas
20 Day; (12) every Sunday; (13) every day designated by public proclama-
21 tion by the President of the United States or the governor of the state
22 as a legal holiday.

23 * Sec. 2 AS 44.12.020 is amended to read:

24 Sec. 2. AS 44.12.020. HOLIDAY FALLING ON SUNDAY. If a holiday
25 listed in sec. 10 of this chapter, except sec. 10(12), falls on a
26 Sunday, Sunday and the following Monday are both legal holidays.

27 * Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on January 1, 1970.
