5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to hiring provisions in state oil
7 and gas leases."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 38.05.180 is amended by adding new subsections to read:

10 (r) Each oil or gas lease issued by the state shall contain a
11 provision requiring that the labor force working at the lease site be
12 composed of at least 20 per cent Alaska Natives.

13 (s) Violation of the lease provision required by (r) of this
14 section, as determined by the commissioner of labor, automatically
15 raises the gross production tax by 50 per cent for the unexpired term
16 of the lease, and no renewal may be granted until the violation has
17 ceased. No person who violates this lease provision may bid for any
18 subsequent oil or gas lease in the state. The appeal procedures of
19 the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62) are available to a lessee
20 in regard to a determination made under this subsection by the
21 commissioner of labor. The commissioner of labor shall promulgate
22 regulations to carry out the provisions of this subsection.
