6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state legal holidays."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 44.12.010 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 44.12.010. LEGAL HOLIDAYS. The following days are legal  
10 holidays: (1) the first of January, known as New Year's Day; (2) the  
11 second Monday in [TWELFTH OF] February, known as Lincoln's Birthday;  
12 (3) the third Monday in [TWENTY-SECOND OF] February, known as  
13 Washington's Birthday; (4) the last Monday in [THIRTIETH OF] March,  
14 known as Seward's Day; (5) the last Monday in [THIRTIETH OF] May, known  
15 as Memorial Day or Decoration Day; (6) the fourth of July, known as  
16 Independence Day; (7) the first Monday in September, known as Labor Day;  
17 (8) the second Monday in [EIGHTEENTH OF] October, known as Alaska Day;  
18 (9) the fourth Monday in October [ELEVENTH OF NOVEMBER], known as  
19 Veteran's Day; (10) the twenty-fifth of December; (11) every Sunday;  
20 (12) every day designated by public proclamation by the President of  
21 the United States or the governor of the state as a legal holiday [OR  
22 AS A DAY OF THANKSGIVING.]; (13) the fourth Thursday in November, known  
23 as Thanksgiving Day.
