5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the state museum."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 44.19.023 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 44.19.023. MANAGEMENT OF STATE MUSEUM. (a) The governor
10 shall manage and have complete charge of all of the property contained
11 in the institution known as the state museum. The museum shall be
12 maintained in the state capital. Branch museums may be established
13 and maintained in other localities in the state.

14 (b) The Office of the Governor shall

15 (1) acquire artifacts, natural history specimens, art objects
16 etc., that pertain to the human and natural history of Alaska by
17 purchase and by gift;

18 (2) identify, catalog, preserve, and display these
19 acquisitions;

20 (3) acquire and catalog Alaskan photographs and maintain a
21 card catalog of this collection;

22 (4) accept endowments, grants, and gifts in accordance with
23 established state policy;

24 (5) collect and maintain books, periodicals, pamphlets, and
25 other materials pertinent to museum administration, techniques and
26 collections;

27 (6) assist and advise in the development of local museums;

28 (7) collect and keep current information concerning museum
29 activities throughout the state;

1 (8) coordinate the museum activities of the state with those
2 of other agencies;

3 (9) keep the museum open at reasonable hours for the con-
4 venience of visitors;

5 (10) provide museum services and administer state and other
6 grants-in-aid to museums in the state to supplement and improve their
7 services, the grants to be paid from funds appropriated for that pur-
8 pose, or from other funds available for that purpose.
