6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for a gubernatorial successor in  
7 the event that both the Governor and Secretary of  
8 State are temporarily outside of the state."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 44.19.150 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 44.19.150. SIMULTANEOUS VACANCIES AND ABSENCES FROM OFFICES.

12 (a) If vacancies in the office of governor and the office of secretary  
13 of state occur simultaneously, the person appointed under sec. 120 of  
14 this chapter succeeds directly to the office of acting governor until  
15 successors to the respective offices are elected in a special election.

16 (b) If the governor and secretary of state are both temporarily  
17 outside of the state, the person appointed under sec. 120 of this  
18 chapter, shall serve as acting governor until either the governor or  
19 secretary of state returns.
