6 For an Act entitled: "An Act requiring nonresident big game hunters to be  
7 accompanied by a guide."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05.407(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) It is unlawful for a nonresident to hunt, pursue or take  
11 a big game animal [BROWN BEAR, GRIZZLY BEAR, POLAR BEAR OR SHEEP] in  
12 this state, unless personally accompanied by a person who is licensed  
13 as a master guide, registered guide or assistant guide by the depart-  
14 ment [, OR WHO IS PERSONALLY ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT ALASKAN OVER  
15 19 YEARS OF AGE WHO IS THE SPOUSE OF OR IS RELATED BY BLOOD WITHIN AND  
16 INCLUDING THE SECOND DEGREE OF KINDRED]. A person who applies for a  
17 nonresident big game tag for the taking of a big game [AN] animal  
18 [SPECIFIED IN THIS SECTION] shall first furnish to the state, on a  
19 form provided by the state, an affidavit showing that he will be  
20 accompanied in his hunt by a person who is qualified under the terms  
21 of this section. A person who falsifies the required affidavit is  
22 guilty of perjury.
