5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled, "An Act relating to the compilation of jury lists."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 09.20.050 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 09.20.050. JURY LIST. At such times as the presiding judge
10 of the superior court in each judicial district may designate, but not
11 less than once every two years, the clerk of the superior court in
12 each judicial district shall prepare a list of the names of residents
13 of the district who are qualified by law for jury service and who are
14 customers either of a public utility owned and operated by a political
15 subdivision of the state or of a public utility regulated by the Alaska
16 Public Service Commission, in addition to those who voted in the pre-
17 ceding general election. If the superior court is located in different
18 cities in the same judicial district, the clerk of the court located
19 in each city shall prepare, at the times designated by the judge but at
20 least every two years, a list of names of persons qualified for jury
21 service and who are customers either of a public utility owned and
22 operated by a political subdivision of the state or of a public
23 utility regulated by the Alaska Public Service Commission, in addition
24 to those who voted in the preceding general election and who are
25 residents of that portion of the judicial district designated by the
26 presiding judge. The list shall be based on the voting list prepared
27 by the secretary of state from the preceding general election and on
28 the lists of subscribers prepared by each public utility and furnished
29 to the superior court of the judicial district in which the utility

1 subscribers are located. A questionnaire for prospective jurors may
2 be adopted and submitted to them by the administrative director of the
3 courts. A copy of the list shall be transmitted to each district
4 magistrate within the judicial district and shall be used to summon
5 jurors residing within the immediate area of the court.
