6 For an Act entitled, "An Act relating to the compilation of jury lists."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1 AS 09.20.050 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 09.20.050. JURY LIST. At such times as the presiding judge  
10 of the superior court in each judicial district may designate, but not  
11 less than once every two years, the clerk of the superior court in each  
12 judicial district shall prepare a list of the names of residents of the  
13 district who are qualified by law for jury service and who either filed  
14 a state income tax return for the preceding year or voted in the preced-  
15 ing general election. If the superior court is located in different  
16 cities in the same judicial district, the clerk of the court located in  
17 each city shall prepare, at the times designated by the judge but at  
18 least every two years, a list of names of persons qualified for jury  
19 service and who either filed a state income tax return for the preceding  
20 year or voted in the preceding general election, and who are residents  
21 of that portion of the judicial district designated by the presiding  
22 judge. The list shall be based on the list of persons, prepared by the  
23 Department of Revenue, who filed a state income tax return for the pre-  
24 ceding year and the voting list prepared by the secretary of state from  
25 the preceding general election. A questionnaire for prospective jurors  
26 may be adopted and submitted to them by the administrative director of  
27 the courts. A copy of the list shall be transmitted to each district  
28 magistrate within the judicial district and shall be used to summon  
29 jurors residing within the immediate area of the court.
