6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the compilation of jury lists."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 09.20.050 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 09.20.050. JURY LIST. At such times as the presiding judge
10 of the superior court in each judicial district may designate, but not
11 less than once every two years, the clerk of the superior court in each
12 judicial district shall prepare a list of the names of residents of the
13 district who are qualified by law for jury service. The list shall con-
14 tain the names of all persons who purchased a resident hunting or fish-
15 ing license, all residents who filed a state income tax return for the
16 preceding year, as well as those persons [AND] who voted in the preced-
17 ing general election. If the superior court is located in different
18 cities in the same judicial district, the clerk of the court located in
19 each city shall prepare, at the times designated by the judge but at
20 least every two years, a list of names of persons qualified for jury
21 service. The list shall contain the names of all persons who purchased
22 a resident hunting or fishing license, all residents who filed a state
23 income tax return for the preceding year, as well as those persons
24 [AND] who voted in the preceding general election and who are residents
25 of that portion of the judicial district designated by the presiding
26 judge. The list shall be based on the list of persons, prepared by the
27 Department of Revenue or the Department of Fish and Game, who purchased
28 a resident hunting or fishing license, who filed a resident state in-
29 come tax return for the preceding year, and the voting list prepared by

1 the secretary of state from the preceding general election. A question-
2 naire for prospective jurors may be adopted and submitted to them by the
3 administrative director of courts. A copy of the list shall be trans-
4 mitted only to each district magistrate within the judicial district
5 and shall be used to summon jurors residing within the immediate area
6 of the court and for no other purpose.
