BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

* Section 1. AS 39.05.150 is amended to read:

Sec. 39.05.150. INFORMATION NOT TO BE REQUESTED OF OR VOLUN-
11 TEERED BY APPLICANT FOR STATE EMPLOYMENT. (a) No state agency or
12 agency supported in whole or in part by state funds may request or
13 suggest that an applicant for employment with that agency provide

(1) information concerning the applicant's religious
15 opinions, his ancestry, his race, or his membership in fraternal
16 organizations;

(2) a photograph of the applicant.

(b) A state agency or state-supported agency shall print the
20 following paragraph at the top of every employment application form
21 used by the agency: "This application will not be considered if the
22 applicant's photograph is included or if the applicant adds infor-
23 mation not requested which may reveal his religious opinions, his
24 ancestry, his race, or his membership in fraternal organizations."
