6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to home rule city powers of planning,
7 platting and zoning."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 07.15.340 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (d) A home rule city which adopted its charter before April 12,
11 1963 may at its option exercise planning, platting and zoning powers
12 within its boundaries in lieu of borough exercise of those powers within
13 the city. The provisions of (a) and (b) of this section do not re-
14 strict the authority conferred in this subsection, and the city may
15 exercise the planning, platting and zoning power as provided in its
16 charter or by ordinance.

17 * Sec. 2. AS 07.15.310 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 07.15.310. SCOPE OF AREAWIDE POWERS. Except as provided in
19 sec. 340(c) of this chapter, first [FIRST] and second class boroughs
20 shall exercise the powers specified in secs. 310 - 350 of this chapter
21 on an areawide basis, both within and outside cities of any class
22 within its boundaries. Except as provided in sec. 340(c) of this
23 chapter, no [NO] city of any class, whether home rule or not, within
24 an organized borough, may exercise any areawide power provided in this
25 section or specified in the petition approved by the voters for in-
26 corporation once that power is being exercised by an organized borough.
