6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to teacher aides."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 14.17 is amended by adding new sections to read:

9 Sec. 14.17.055. TEACHER AIDE SALARY ALLOTMENT. (a) Each district
10 is entitled to the number of teacher aides based on the equivalent of
11 one for every four teachers allowed under sec. 50 of this chapter.

12 (b) The allotment shall be 75 per cent of the actual expenditure
13 for teacher aides up to the number of aides authorized, and may not
14 exceed \$4,000 for each aide.

15 Sec. 14.17.057. TEACHER AIDES IN STATE-OPERATED SCHOOLS WITH
16 LESS THAN FOUR TEACHERS. When a state-operated school has less than
17 four teachers it is entitled to a portion of a teacher aide's time as
18 follows:

19 (1) a one- or two-teacher school is entitled to a half-time
20 teacher aide;

21 (2) a three-teacher school is entitled to a three-fourths
22 time teacher aide.

23 * Sec. 2. AS 14.17.250 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

24 (13) "teacher aide" means a staff member performing
25 assigned activities primarily of a nonteaching nature which are not
26 classified as professional educational, but which assist a staff
27 member to perform professional educational teaching assignments.
