6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the establishment of guiding  
7 districts."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.50 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 Sec. 16.50.245. ESTABLISHMENT OF GUIDING DISTRICTS. The state  
11 shall be divided into six guide districts consisting of

12 (1) Southeastern - Units 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5;

13 (2) Southcentral - Units 6, 7, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16;

14 (3) Southwestern - Units 8, 9, 10 and 17;

15 (4) Central - Units 18, 19, 20, 21, 24 and 25;

16 (5) Arctic Coast - that portion of Units 22, 23 and 26

17 lying within 50 miles of the Bering Sea and Arctic Ocean, including  
18 islands in these units;

19 (6) Interior-Arctic - that portion of Units 22, 23 and 26  
20 not included in (5) of this section.

21 Sec. 16.50.250. REGULATIONS. The board shall promulgate regu-  
22 lations it considers advisable in regulating the assignment of guide  
23 districts and the issuing of permits to guides for guiding in those  
24 districts.

25 Sec. 16.50.255. LIMITATION OF PERMITS FOR GUIDING DISTRICTS.

26 (a) No guide is eligible to receive a permit to guide in more than  
27 two districts of Alaska.

28 (b) When a guide district becomes unproductive the district  
29 shall be closed to guiding pending a hearing by the board as to the

1 cause of the unproductiveness. If the guide is found to be the cause  
2 of the unproductiveness, he shall be ineligible to receive a permit to  
3 guide in another district, other than the second district for which he  
4 was originally eligible.

5 Sec. 16.50.260. PREFERENCES. Preference shall be given to a  
6 guide for a guiding district assignment according to the

- 7 (1) length of the guide's residency in the district;
- 8 (2) length of the guide's time guiding in the district;
- 9 (3) number of the guide's violations under this title.

10 Sec. 16.50.265. GUIDE PERMITS NONTRANSFERABLE. The holder of a  
11 guide permit in any of the districts in sec. 245 of this chapter may  
12 not transfer or sell his guide permit.
