6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the authority of the State  
7 Commission for Human Rights."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 18.80.133. TEMPORARY INJUNCTION. If the informal efforts  
11 to eliminate the alleged discrimination are unsuccessful and the  
12 commission schedules a hearing, the commission may obtain a court  
13 order restraining the conduct alleged in the complaint to be discrim-  
14 inatory, if it appears to the court that the complaint is valid and  
15 that continuation of the conduct would produce injury to the complain-  
16 ant. The order may remain in force for only 10 days or, if the  
17 hearing has begun by the tenth day, until the hearing is completed.  
18 This is not a limitation on enforcement of orders issued by the  
19 commission at the completion of a hearing.
