5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Human Rights Commission."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 18.80.060(5) is amended to read:

9 (5) study the problems of discrimination in all or specific
10 fields of human relationships, and foster through community effort or
11 goodwill, cooperation and conciliation among the groups and elements of
12 the population of the state, and publish results of investigations and
13 research as in its judgment will tend to eliminate discrimination be-
14 cause of race, religion, color, [OR] national ancestry, physical
15 handicap, age or sex.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

17 Sec. 18.80.105. TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER. At any time after
18 a complaint is filed under sec. 100 of this chapter, alleging an
19 unlawful discriminatory practice, the commission may file a petition
20 in the superior court in the judicial district in which the subject of
21 the complaint occurs, or in the judicial district in which a respondent
22 resides or transacts business, seeking appropriate temporary relief
23 against the respondent, pending final determination of proceedings under
24 this chapter, including an order or decree restraining him from doing
25 or procuring any act tending to render ineffectual any order the com-
26 mission may enter with respect to the complaint. The court has the
27 power to grant the temporary relief or restraining order it considers
28 just and proper; however, no relief or order extending beyond 10 days
29 may be granted except by consent of the respondent or after hearing

1 upon notice to the respondent and a finding by the court that there is
2 reasonable cause to believe that the respondent has engaged in dis-
3 criminatory practices.

4 * Sec. 3. AS 18.80 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 18.80.215. ACTIVITIES IN AID OF HOUSING FOR MINORITY GROUPS.

6 The activities of a nonprofit and noncommercial organization on a non-
7 remunerative basis in aiding minority group members to obtain housing
8 opportunities so as to further the purpose of this chapter shall not
9 be considered a violation of AS 08.88.161.

10 * Sec. 4. AS 18.80.220(1) is amended to read:

11 (1) an employer to refuse employment to a person, or to bar
12 him from employment, or to discriminate against him in compensation or
13 in a term, condition, or privilege of employment because of his race,
14 religion, color or national origin, or because of his age, physical
15 handicap or sex when the reasonable demands of the position do not
16 require age, physical handicap or sex distinction;
