6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the return transportation of  
7 employees."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 23.10.380 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 23.10.380. RIGHT TO RETURN TRANSPORTATION OR ITS EQUIVALENT.

11 (a) An employer who furnishes, finances, agrees to furnish or finance,  
12 or in any way provides transportation for a person from the place of  
13 hire to a point inside or outside the state to employ him shall provide  
14 the person with return transportation to the place of hire from which  
15 transportation was furnished or financed, or to a destination agreed  
16 upon by the parties, with transportation to be furnished or financed

17 (1) on or after the termination of employment [FOR A CAUSE  
18 CONSIDERED GOOD AND SUFFICIENT BY THE DEPARTMENT, BEYOND THE CONTROL OF  
19 THE PERSON,] for any reason or on or after the termination of the  
20 contract of employment or a renewal of the contract; and

21 (2) upon the request of the person or the department made  
22 within 45 days after the termination of employment.

23 (b) Upon the termination of employment the subsistence of the  
24 employee may not continue longer than 10 days after the termination or  
25 until transportation is available, whichever occurs first.

26 (c) Upon the termination of employment the terminated employee  
27 may elect to receive the cash equivalent of the cost of his transporta-  
28 tion to the place of hire. If he elects to receive the cash equivalent  
29 of the transportation, he shall also receive the cash equivalent of the

1 cost of his subsistence for the period he would have had to wait until  
2 the first transportation became available, but in any case not longer  
3 than 10 days.

5       Sec. 23.10.392. NOTICE. An employer shall give notice of the  
6 provisions of secs. 375 - 400 of this chapter by posting a copy of  
7 secs. 375 - 400 of this chapter, and keeping it posted conspicuously  
8 at or near the place of work where the statement can be seen by each  
9 employee as he comes or goes to his place of work.
