6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the licensing of barbers; and  
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 08.12.070 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

10 (4) evidence that he is at least 18 years of age.

11 \* Sec. 2. AS 08.12.160 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

12 Sec. 08.12.160. TEMPORARY PERMIT. (a) The board may issue a  
13 temporary permit to engage in barbering to any person, entering the  
14 state or transferring from a practice exempt under the provisions of  
15 sec. 270 of this chapter, who has

16 (1) a diploma from a barber college accredited by the  
17 board, or

18 (2) a master or registered barber license issued by another  
19 state or territory.

20 (b) A person holding a temporary permit must be under the direct  
21 supervision of a master barber. The permit is valid until the next  
22 examination given by the board.

23 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
24 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
