6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the discharge of firearms for  
7 purposes of lawful hunting in state parks; and  
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 11.55.050 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 11.55.050. FLOURISHING, POINTING OR DISCHARGING FIREARM  
12 IN PUBLIC PLACE. (a) Except as provided in (b) of this section, a  
13 [A] person who flourishes, points or discharges a firearm in a city,  
14 town, village or other community, or in or on a railway coach, steam-  
15 boat or steamship, or in or near a park or public grounds, or at a  
16 public place, whether public in itself, or made public at the time  
17 by an assemblage of persons, is guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon  
18 conviction is punishable by a fine of not more than \$500, or by  
19 imprisonment in a jail for not more than six months, or by both.

20 (b) Firearms may be discharged for purposes of lawful hunting  
21 in any state park where not prohibited by regulations of the  
22 Department of Natural Resources.

23 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
24 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
