6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to electrical contractors; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.40.130 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.40.130. LICENSING OF APPLICANTS OTHER THAN INDIVIDUALS.

11 (a) Each applicant, other than an individual, shall designate a
12 supervisory employee or member of the firm to take the required examina-
13 tion. This person shall be designated as administrator under the
14 license. No person may qualify as administrator under more than one
15 license. If the relationship of the administrator with the applicant
16 firm or corporation is terminated, the license is void within 90 days
17 unless another administrator is qualified by the board. A license
18 issued under this section is valid for two years [ONE YEAR] after
19 issuance, unless revoked or suspended, is nontransferable and may be
20 renewed biennially on January 1 without examination by appropriate
21 application.

22 (b) A lapsed license may be reinstated by payment of all unpaid
23 renewal fees and a penalty fee of \$25 for each year the license has
24 been lapsed unless the license has been lapsed for more than three
25 years and the board has reason to believe that it may be necessary to
26 require the licensee to take and pass the examination given pursuant
27 to sec. 120 of this chapter.

29 (b) The fee for biennial renewal of a license is \$100 [\$50].

1 * Sec. 3. AS 08.40.170 is amended to read:

2 Sec. 08.40.170. SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF LICENSE. (a) The
3 board may suspend, [OR] revoke or refuse to grant a license upon a
4 finding that

5 (1) the application is fraudulent or misleading;

6 (2) the licensee has knowingly violated this chapter or a
7 lawful rule, order or regulation of the board;

8 (3) the licensee is incompetent, or has engaged in fraudu-
9 lent practices.

10 (b) Notice of a proposed denial, suspension or revocation of
11 license shall be given in writing, stating the grounds.

12 (c) Proceedings for the denial, suspension or revocation of a
13 license shall be governed by the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).

14 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
15 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
