6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to electrical contractors; and pro-
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.40.130 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 08.40.130. LICENSING OF APPLICANTS OTHER THAN INDIVIDUALS.
11 Each applicant, other than an individual, shall designate a supervisory
12 employee or member of the firm to take the required examination. This
13 person shall be designated as administrator under the license. No
14 person may qualify as administrator under more than one license. If
15 the relationship of the administrator with the applicant firm or
16 corporation is terminated, the license is void within 90 days unless
17 another administrator is qualified by the board. [A LICENSE ISSUED
18 UNDER THIS SECTION IS VALID FOR ONE YEAR AFTER ISSUANCE, UNLESS RE-
19 VOKED OR SUSPENDED, IS NONTRANSFERABLE AND MAY BE RENEWED WITHOUT
20 EXAMINATION BY APPROPRIATE APPLICATION.]

21 * Sec. 2. AS 08.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

22 Sec. 08.40.135. RENEWAL AND REINSTATEMENT. (a) A license issued
23 under this chapter is valid for two years after issuance, unless
24 revoked or suspended, is nontransferable and may be renewed biennially
25 on January 1, without examination, by appropriate application.

26 (b) A lapsed license may be reinstated by payment of all unpaid
27 renewal fees and a penalty fee of \$25 for each year the license has
28 been lapsed unless the license has been lapsed for more than three
29 years and the board has reason to believe that it may be necessary to

1 require the licensee to take and pass the examination given under
2 sec. 120 of this chapter.

3 * Sec. 3. AS 08.40.150(b) is amended to read:

4 (b) The fee for biennial renewal of a license is \$100 [\$50].

5 * Sec. 4. AS 08.40.170 is amended to read:

6 Sec. 08.40.170. DENIAL, SUSPENSION AND REVOCATION OF LICENSE.

7 (a) The board may suspend, [OR] revoke or refuse to grant a license
8 upon a finding that

9 (1) the application is fraudulent or misleading;

10 (2) the licensee has knowingly violated this chapter or a
11 lawful rule, order or regulation of the board;

12 (3) the licensee is incompetent, or has engaged in fraudu-
13 lent practices.

14 (b) Notice of a proposed denial, suspension or revocation of
15 license shall be given in writing, stating the grounds.

16 (c) Proceedings for the denial, suspension or revocation of a
17 license shall be governed by the Administrative Procedure Act (AS 44.62).

18 * Sec. 5. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
19 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
