6 For an Act entitled: "An Act defining the term 'natural disaster' for pur-
7 poses of expenditures from the disaster relief fund."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 44.19.175 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 44.19.175. DEFINITION. In secs. 171(b)(1) and (2) of this
11 chapter "natural disaster" means a flood, fire, drought, earthquake,
12 tidal wave, typhoon, storm or other calamity [NATURAL DISASTER]
13 occurring in any part of the state after October 11, 1967 and pro-
14 claimed by the governor to be of such severity and magnitude as to
15 warrant state action to supplement local efforts and available resources
16 in alleviating damage, hardship, or suffering caused by the calamity
17 [DECLARED BY THE PRESIDENT OF THE UNITED STATES TO BE A MAJOR DISASTER
18 UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE FEDERAL DISASTER ACT OF 1950, TITLE 42,
19 UNITED STATES CODE, SECS. 1855-1855g].
