5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to university and college tuition;
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 14.40.065. TUITION. No basic tuition fee may be charged a
11 resident of Alaska during his freshman or sophomore year at the Uni-
12 versity of Alaska or a college or department established under it,
13 except that this free tuition benefit may not continue beyond a maximum
14 of 75 semester hours. This section does not exclude normal charges for
15 textbooks, room and board and other nonacademic fees.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 14.40 is amended by adding a new section to read:

17 Sec. 14.40.605. TUITION. No basic tuition fee may be charged a
18 resident of Alaska who attends a community college established under
19 secs. 560 - 640 of this chapter. This section does not exclude normal
20 charges for textbooks, room and board and other nonacademic fees.

21 * Sec. 3. AS 14.40.610 is amended to read:

22 Sec. 14.40.610. DISPOSITION OF INCOME. (a) All money [, INCLUD-
23 ING TUITION] and fees received before or after April 10, 1962, from the
24 operations of a community college established, operated, and maintained
25 under secs. 560 - 640 of this chapter and directly related or attribut-
26 able to academic degree programs and activities, shall be placed in the
27 community college fund of the University of Alaska.

28 (b) All money [, INCLUDING TUITION] and fees received before or
29 after April 10, 1962, from the operations of a community college

1 established, operated and maintained under secs. 560 - 640 of this
2 chapter and directly related or attributable to nondegree programs and
3 activities of the community college, shall be placed in the appropriate
4 fund of the qualified school district or political subdivision co-
5 operating with the university in the establishment of the community
6 college.

7 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
8 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
