6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the judicial district in which an
7 existing or former superior court judge is to seek
8 voter approval in case of his appointment as judge
9 in another judicial district; and providing for an
10 effective date."

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

12 * Section 1. AS 15.35.080 is amended to read:

13 Sec. 15.35.080. DETERMINATION OF JUDICIAL DISTRICT IN WHICH TO
14 SEEK APPROVAL. The judge shall seek approval in the judicial district
15 to which he was [ORIGINALLY] appointed, except in case of assignments
16 and transfers with the judge's consent, and in case of the appointment
17 of an existing or former judge to a judgeship in another judicial
18 district in which case he shall seek approval in the district where he
19 has served the major portion of his time as judge [TERM]. The judge
20 shall designate on his declaration of candidacy the judicial district
21 to which he was appointed, except in case of assignments and transfers,
22 and in the case of appointment of an existing or former judge to
23 another judicial district, in which case he shall designate the
24 district where he has served the major portion of his time as judge
25 [TERM].

26 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
27 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
