6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Pioneers Home."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 47.25.020(b) is amended to read:

9 (b) Every person admitted to the Pioneers Home, except a person  
10 admitted under sec. 30 of this chapter, who receives income from any  
11 source in excess of \$35 [\$20] a month may be required by the Department  
12 of Administration to pay the excess to the Department of Administration  
13 immediately upon receipt of the money in payment, or part payment, of  
14 the cost of his maintenance. No charge may be made in excess of the  
15 cost of care and maintenance.

17 Sec. 47.25.030. ADMISSION ON PAYMENT. A citizen of the United  
18 States over 65 years of age who is a resident of the state and has been  
19 a resident for not less than 15 years continuously immediately preceding  
20 his application, but who is not destitute, may on application be  
21 admitted to the home upon his agreement to pay to the state a sum for  
22 each day as the Department of Administration considers sufficient to  
23 compensate the state for the cost of care and support of the person  
24 at the home. No charge may be made in excess of the cost of care  
25 and maintenance. When this agreement is entered into the Department  
26 of Administration may receive the security for the payments, which it  
27 considers expedient.
