6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for the appointment of three persons
7 as sequential successors to the secretary of state;
8 and providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 44.19.120 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 44.19.120. APPOINTMENT OF SUCCESSOR TO SECRETARY OF STATE.

12 After taking his initial term of office, the governor shall appoint
13 three persons [FROM AMONG THE OFFICERS WHO HEAD THE PRINCIPAL DEPART-
14 MENTS OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT OR OTHERWISE, A PERSON] to succeed, in
15 sequence, to the office of secretary of state if the office of secretary
16 of state becomes vacant, and shall specify the sequence of their suc-
17 cession. The appointments are [APPOINTMENT IS] subject to confirmation
18 by a majority of the members of the legislature meeting in joint
19 session. The persons [PERSON] designated and confirmed are [IS] next
20 in line for succession to the office of secretary of state, and succeed
21 to office in the sequence specified in their appointment, subject to the
22 pleasure of the governor. If any of the persons [PERSON] designated
23 and confirmed is removed from or vacates the appointment, or if an
24 appointee succeeds to the office of secretary of state, the governor
25 shall appoint a successor subject to confirmation in the same manner as
26 the persons [PERSON] initially appointed.

27 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
