6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to departmental boards."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 * Section 1. AS 39.05.060 is amended to read:

9 Sec. 39.05.060. APPOINTMENT, QUALIFICATIONS, COMPENSATION, AND
10 TERMS OF OFFICE OF MEMBERS OF DEPARTMENTAL BOARDS, COUNCILS, OR COM-
11 MISSIONS. Each member of the Local Boundary Commission, Alcoholic
12 Beverage Control Board, Employment Security Advisory Council, Alaska
13 State Housing Authority, Board of Fish and Game, Board of Parole,
14 Alaska Workman's Compensation [BOARD OF TOURISM] and the Commission for
15 Northern Operations of Rail Transportation and Highways, shall be a
16 citizen of the United States. The governor shall appoint each member
17 on the basis of interest in public affairs, good judgment, knowledge
18 and ability in the field of action of the department for which appointed,
19 and with a view to providing diversity of interest and points of view
20 in the membership. Appointments are subject to confirmation by a
21 majority of the members of the legislature in joint session. Initial
22 appointments of members are as follows: (1) in the case of three-
23 member boards, for one, two and three years; (2) in the case of five-
24 member boards, for one, two, three, four and five years; (3) in the
25 case of six-member boards, two members serve for one year, two for two
26 years, and two for three years; (4) and in the case of eight-member
27 boards, two members serve for one year, two for two years, two for
28 three years, and two for four years; (5) and in the case of 10-member
29 boards, two members serve for one year, two for two years, two for

1 three years, two for four years, and two for five years. Initial
2 terms date from February 1 before appointment. A vacancy occurring
3 during a term of office is filled in the same manner as the original
4 appointment is made and for the balance of the unexpired term. Each
5 member holds office at the pleasure of the governor notwithstanding
6 the member's term.
