Sec. 04.10.270. ~~RECOMMENDATION OF CITY COUNCIL~~ OR BOROUGH ASSEMBLY

IN LIEU OF PUBLIC CONSENT. An application for a transfer, renewal or
11 new license coming from within an incorporated municipality [TOWN] shall
12 have attached to the application, in lieu of the consent required in
13 sec. 190(a)(5) of this chapter a recommendation of the city council
14 or borough assembly of the incorporated municipality [TOWN], together
15 with a list of at least five references from within the corporate
16 boundaries of the municipality [TOWN], as to the integrity of the
17 applicant and the desirability of issuing a license for the premises
18 mentioned in the application. This recommendation is binding on the
19 board unless the board after a hearing as provided in this title
20 determines that the city council or borough assembly acted in a capri-
21 cious or arbitrary manner, and states in writing its findings as to the
22 capricious or arbitrary aspects of the action of the council or
23 assembly. The failure of the city council or borough assembly to act
24 upon an application for license within 30 days of receipt of the
25 application is a default and subjects the city to the penalty of losing
26 its right to the refund provided in sec. 460 of this chapter.
