6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing school boards of seven members in  
7 borough or city school districts having an average  
8 daily membership of 5,000 or less; and providing for  
9 an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 \* Section 1. AS 14.12.030(a) is amended to read:

12 (a) Each borough and city school district with an average daily  
13 membership of 5,000 or less has a school board of five members, except  
14 that the governing body of the borough or city may by ordinance, con-  
15 curred in by a majority of the district school board, provide for a  
16 school board of seven members.

17 \* Sec. 2. AS 14.12.040 is amended to read:

18 Sec. 14.12.040. TRANSITION. The transition from a five-man to a  
19 seven-man school board shall be made at the regular election following,  
20 or being held within 90 days preceding, the completion of the second  
21 regular school term during which the district maintains an average daily  
22 membership exceeding 5,000 or at the regular election following the  
23 effective date of an ordinance increasing board membership as provided  
24 in sec. 30(a) of this chapter. Once the district has a seven-man school  
25 board, the number of members shall not be changed [REGARDLESS OF THE  
26 AVERAGE DAILY MEMBERSHIP].

27 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
