6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to land selections by local  
7 governments."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 07.10.150 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 07.10.150. STATE LANDS. An organized borough may select  
11 10 per cent of the vacant, unappropriated, unreserved state lands  
12 located in its boundaries [WITHIN FIVE YEARS AFTER THE DATE OF  
13 AVAILABILITY OF STATE LANDS IN THE BOROUGH]. Nothing in this section  
14 affects any valid existing claim, location, or entry under the laws of  
15 the state or the United States, whether for homestead, mineral, right-  
16 of-way, or other purpose, or affects the rights of any owner, claimant,  
17 locator, or entryman to the full use and enjoyment of the land so  
18 occupied.

19 \* Sec. 2. AS 07.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

20 Sec. 07.05.040. STATE LANDS. A city of the first or second class  
21 may select 10 per cent of the vacant, unappropriated, unreserved state  
22 lands located in its boundaries. Nothing in this section affects any  
23 valid existing claim, location or entry under the laws of the state or  
24 the United States whether for homestead, mineral, right-of-way, or  
25 other purpose, or affects the rights of any owner, claimant, locator,  
26 or entryman to the full use and enjoyment of the land so occupied.
