6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to exclusion of home rule cities from
7 the boundaries of first or second class boroughs; and
8 providing for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 * Section 1. AS 07.15.020 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 07.15.020. ANNEXATION AND EXCLUSION. First and second class
12 boroughs have the same powers of annexation and exclusion as first class
13 cities and shall follow the same procedures for annexation and exclusion
14 as first class cities, except that

15 (1) article V of the state constitution governs voting
16 qualifications, and

17 (2) if a sufficient petition for the exclusion of a home rule
18 city from a first or second class borough is presented to the borough
19 assembly, AS 29.70.030 - 29.70.050 may not apply to the proposed ex-
20 clusion and the borough assembly, within 30 days after presentation of
21 the petition shall enact a resolution containing

22 (A) the name and legal description of the city to be
23 excluded,

24 (B) the obligations, if any, which shall make the
25 property to be excluded subject to borough taxation for payment of
26 the property's share of prior bonded indebtedness incurred for
27 borough areawide functions directly benefiting the property and of
28 special assessments levied for borough capital improvements
29 directly benefiting the property;

1 (C) The date of the special election for the question of
2 exclusion if a protest is filed, the election to be held not later
3 than 90 days after the enactment of the resolution; and

4 (D) the proposed effective date of the exclusion, the
5 date to be no later than 90 days after the date of the enactment
6 of the resolution, or 90 days after the date of the special election
7 held upon the question of exclusion.

8 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
9 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
