6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to salmon gear license fees; and pro-  
7 viding for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 16.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.534. SPECIAL SALMON GEAR LICENSE FEES. (a) The Board  
11 of Fish and Game, with the concurrence of a local advisory committee  
12 established under sec. 260 of this chapter, may designate distressed  
13 salmon fishing districts where in its opinion excessive fishing gear  
14 presents severe resource management or conservation problems or where  
15 excessive fishing gear is having an adverse effect on the health and  
16 welfare of the citizens of the state.

17 (b) In areas designated in (a) of this section, a special salmon  
18 gear license fee may be levied. This fee shall be in addition to the  
19 regular commercial fishing license and gear fees and shall be equal to  
20 three per cent of the value of salmon sold by a resident fisherman and  
21 equal to nine per cent of the value of the salmon taken in the waters of  
22 this state that are sold by nonresident fishermen, except that this fee  
23 may not be charged to a fisherman, resident or nonresident, who can  
24 demonstrate upon demand to the Department of Revenue that his gross in-  
25 come for the previous year was less than \$4,000. A fee collected under  
26 this section is computed, filed and enforced in the same manner as pre-  
27 scribed in the license tax law for salmon canneries.

28 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
29 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
