SENATE BILL NO. 272

IN THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA

SIXTH LEGISLATURE - FIRST SESSION

A BILL

For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to scholarships for Alaska Natives."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

\* Section 1. AS 14.40.520 is amended to read:

Sec. 14.40.520. SCHOLARSHIPS. The Board of Regents of the University of Alaska shall offer not more than 50 [15] new scholarships for each academic year to Alaska Natives desiring to attend the University of Alaska. The board shall give preference to Natives residing in the rural areas of the state who desire to receive training in the field of education. If there are more than 50 [15] applications the board shall award 50 [15] scholarships to those applicants who have the highest scholastic record or who the board determines are the most qualified among the applicants and who are financially unable to obtain a higher education without assistance. The University shall provide such minimum financial assistance to these students as is necessary in each individual case, but not exceeding fees, board and room.
