6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for relocation of the capital from  
7 Juneau to the Big Lake-Wasilla area; and providing for  
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 44.06.010 is amended to read:

11 Sec. 44.06.010. SITE OF CAPITAL. The capital of the state is at  
12 the Big Lake-Wasilla area of [THE CITY OF JUNEAU,] Alaska.

13 \* Sec. 2. The specific site of the capital under this Act shall be  
14 designated by the legislature after consideration of the recommendations of  
15 a capital relocation commission. The commission shall consist of three  
16 members of each house of the legislature appointed to the commission by the  
17 governor and representing the three most populous election districts of each  
18 house.

19 \* Sec. 3. Section 1 of this Act takes effect on the date that the pro-  
20 posed oil pipeline linking North Slope oil fields within an Alaska port is  
21 completed and placed into service.

22 \* Sec. 4. Section 2 of this Act takes effect one year after its passage  
23 and approval or its becoming law without approval.
