6 For an Act entitled: "An Act authorizing state aid to local school districts
7 which bear the impact of educating children whose
8 parent works on or lives on state property; and pro-
9 viding for an effective date."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

11 * Section 1. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to read:

12 Sec. 14.17.215. STATE AID TO DISTRICTS AFFECTED BY STATE ACTIVI-
13 TIES. A school district which provides free public education to a
14 student whose parent works on or lives on state property shall receive
15 an additional yearly allotment under this chapter equal to the percent-
16 age of the state average cost of education, as reflected in the audit
17 report of district schools for the prior fiscal year, per student times
18 the number of qualifying students in average daily membership, as
19 follows:

20 (1) 50 per cent for a student whose parent lives on and work
21 on state property;

22 (2) 25 per cent for a student whose parent works on state
23 property.

24 (b) In this section "state property" means real property which is
25 owned by the state or is leased by the state and which is not subject
26 to taxation or payments in lieu of taxes by the state or a political
27 subdivision of the state; the term includes real property owned by the
28 state and leased from it, as well as improvements leased from it, even
29 though the lessee's interest, or an improvement on the property, is

1 subject to taxation by a state or a political subdivision of the state.

2 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
