6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to conservation provisions in certain  
7 oil and gas leases and drilling permits; and providing  
8 for an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 38.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

11 Sec. 38.05.178. CONSERVATION PROVISIONS IN OIL OR GAS LEASES AND  
12 DRILLING PERMITS. (a) No oil or gas lease on shorelands, tidelands,  
13 or submerged lands, may be issued after May 1, 1969 until the legisla-  
14 ture in regular or special session has reviewed and approved the lease  
15 by concurrent resolution. The legislature shall approve the lease only  
16 if it contains provisions requiring the lessee in his use of the land  
17 to protect and conserve fisheries, waterfowl, aquatic mammals, and all  
18 resources of fresh and sea water.

19 (b) No oil or gas lease on shorelands, tidelands, or submerged  
20 lands issued before May 1, 1969, on which no drilling permit has been  
21 issued by May 1, 1969, may be issued a drilling permit until the com-  
22 missioner of fish and game has reviewed the terms of the permit and is  
23 assured provisions have been made requiring the permittee in his use  
24 of the land to protect and conserve fisheries, waterfowl, aquatic mam-  
25 mals, and all resources of fresh and sea water.

26 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
27 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
