6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska State Housing  
7 Authority's urban renewal program; and providing for  
8 an effective date."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

10 \* Section 1. AS 18.55.490 is amended to read:

11 AS 18.55.490. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the legis-  
12 lature in secs. 480 - 960 of this chapter to take advantage of title 1  
13 of the Housing Act of 1949 (Public Law 171, 81st Congress), as amended.

14 \* Sec. 2. AS 18.55.520 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

15 (12) to prepare or have prepared neighborhood development  
16 plans and to recommend development projects to the governing body of  
17 any municipality within that neighborhood consistent with the plans  
18 to be undertaken and carried out.

19 \* Sec. 3. AS 18.55 is amended by adding a new section to read:

20 AS 18.55.525. NEIGHBORHOOD DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS. (a) A  
21 neighborhood development project which is undertaken and administered  
22 by the authority shall consist of urban renewal project undertakings  
23 and activities in one or more urban renewal areas which are planned  
24 and carried out on the basis of annual increments in accordance with  
25 provisions of secs. 131 - 135 of title 1 of the Housing Act of 1949  
26 (Public Law 171, 81st Congress), as amended.

27 (b) The provisions of secs. 480 - 960 of this chapter, whenever  
28 applicable, shall be adhered to in the planning and carrying out of a  
29 neighborhood development project by the authority.

1 \* Sec. 4. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and  
2 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
