5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the establishment of a state  
7 publications library distribution center."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 14.56 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 2. STATE PUBLICATIONS LIBRARY DISTRIBUTING CENTER.

11 Sec. 14.56.090. STATE PUBLICATIONS LIBRARY DISTRIBUTION CENTER  
12 ESTABLISHED. There is established in the state library a state publica-  
13 tions library distribution center.

14 Sec. 14.56.100. DUTIES OF CENTER. The state publications library  
15 distribution center shall promote the establishment of an orderly de-  
16 pository library system.

17 Sec. 14.56.110. REGULATIONS. The Department of Education shall  
18 adopt regulations necessary to carry out the provisions of secs. 90 - 180  
19 of this chapter.

20 Sec. 14.56.120. DEPOSIT OF PUBLICATIONS. (a) Each state agency  
21 shall deposit, upon release, at least four copies of each of its state  
22 publications with the state library for record and depository purposes  
23 in the state publications library distribution center. Additional  
24 copies of each publication may be requested by the center for deposit in  
25 quantities necessary to meet the needs of the depository library system  
26 and to provide inter-library service to those libraries not having  
27 depository status.

28 (b) The state library, state publications library distribution  
29 center, is also a depository for municipal publications,

1 including surveys and studies produced by a municipality or for it on  
2 contract. Four copies of each municipal publication shall be deposited  
3 with the state library for record and distributory purposes in the  
4 state publications library distributions center.

5 Sec. 14.56.130. OTHER DOCUMENTS REQUIRED OF STATE AGENCIES. Upon  
6 the request of the center, a state agency shall furnish the center with  
7 a complete list of its current state publications and a copy of its  
8 mailing or exchange lists.

9 Sec. 14.56.140. LIST OF PUBLICATIONS. The center shall publish  
10 and distribute regularly to contracting depository libraries, and to  
11 other libraries upon request, a list of available state publications on  
12 file.

13 Sec. 14.56.150. DEPOSITORY LIBRARY CONTRACTS. The center may  
14 enter into depository contracts with municipal, university or community  
15 college libraries, public library associations, state library agencies  
16 and the Library of Congress. The requirements for eligibility to  
17 contract as a depository library shall be established by the Department  
18 of Education upon the recommendation of the state librarian and shall  
19 include and take into consideration the type of library, its ability  
20 to preserve publications and to make them available for public use,  
21 and the geographical location of the library for ease of access to  
22 residents in all areas of the state.

23 Sec. 14.56.160 DEPOSITORY LIBRARY DESIGNATIONS. Libraries may  
24 be designated as either "complete depository" or "selective depository."  
25 A complete depository library shall be sent one copy of every state  
26 publication. A selective depository library shall be sent one copy of  
27 every publication from the specific state agencies it designates.

28 Sec. 14.56.170. LIMITED DISTRIBUTION OF STATE PUBLICATIONS. The  
29 center may not engage in general public distribution of either state

1 publications or lists of publications.

2 Sec. 14.56.180. DEFINITIONS. In secs. 90 - 180 of this chapter,  
3 unless the context otherwise requires,

4 (1) "center" means the state publications library distribution  
5 center;

6 (2) "state agency" includes state department, divisions,  
7 agencies, boards, associations, commissions, corporations and offices;

8 (3) "municipal" and "municipality" include cities and  
9 organized boroughs of every class;

10 (4) "state publication" includes any official document,  
11 compilation, journal, bill, law, resolution, bluebook, statute, code,  
12 register, pamphlet, list, book, report, study, hearing transcript,  
13 leaflet, order, regulation, directory, periodical or magazine issued or  
14 contracted for by a state agency.
