6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to compensation of judicial and state
7 officers; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 22.05.140(a) is amended to read:

10 (a) The chief justice shall receive \$28,000 [\$27,000] annually,
11 and each associate justice shall receive \$27,000 [\$26,000] annually as
12 compensation. The compensation is payable monthly in 12 equal install-
13 ments. Compensation of the chief justice or of an associate justice
14 shall not be diminished during his term of office, unless by general law
15 applying to all salaried officers of the state.

16 * Sec. 2. AS 22.10.190(a) is amended to read:

17 (a) Each superior court judge shall receive \$24,000 [\$23,000]
18 annually, as compensation, payable monthly in 12 equal installments.
19 The compensation of a judge shall not be diminished during his term of
20 office, unless by general law applying to all salaried officers of the
21 state.

22 * Sec. 3. AS 22.15.220(a) is amended to read:

23 (a) Each district judge shall receive annual compensation to be
24 determined by the supreme court, but, in any event, not less than
25 \$18,500 [\$15,500 OR MORE THAN \$17,500]. Compensation shall be payable
26 annually in 12 equal monthly installments.

27 * Sec. 4. This Act takes effect July 1, 1969.
