6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Alaska Board of Welding
7 examiners."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 08.99.030 is amended to read:

10 CHAPTER 99. BOARD OF WELDING AND PIPING EXAMINERS.

11 Sec. 08.99.030. SOURCE OF APPOINTMENTS. The governor shall
12 appoint board members from a list of persons prepared by the Alaska
13 Chapter of American Welding Society and the Alaska Society of Pro-
14 fessional Engineers and submitted at least 30 days before the expiration
15 of a term and not more than 60 days after a vacancy occurs in an
16 unexpired term. The list shall contain not less than two recommended
17 candidates for each appointment. The governor shall make appointments
18 within 30 days after receiving the list.

19 * Sec. 2. AS 08.99.050 is amended to read:

20 Sec. 08.99.050. QUALIFICATIONS OF BOARD MEMBERS. Each member
21 of the board shall be a citizen of the United States and a resident of
22 the state. At least three members shall be professional practicing
23 mechanical engineers with at least five years experience as a profes-
24 sional engineer. All members shall have extensive experience in the
25 welding or the piping field.

26 * Sec. 3. AS 08.99.080 is amended by adding new paragraphs to read:

27 (9) promulgate rules and regulations concerning reports,
28 affidavits and certificates of compliance necessary to assure the
29 board that industry is complying with the requirements of sec. 110 of

1 this chapter and that the state's best interests are being served;

2 (10) designate the procedures for inspection and inspection
3 records for all welding and piping work done in the state.

4 * Sec. 4. AS 08.99 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 Sec. 08.99.110. PIPING CODES. The United States of America
6 Standard Institute Codes listed below are established as the piping
7 codes for the State of Alaska:

8 (1) B 31.1 - 1955A code for pressure piping

9 (2) B 31.1 - 8 1967 code for gas transmission and distribu-
10 tion piping system

11 (3) B 31.3 - 1966 petroleum refining piping

12 (4) B 31.4 - 1966 oil transportation piping.
