6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the Small Grain Incentive Program;  
7 and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 03.19.030(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) The incentive payment per ton for an area shall be adjusted  
11 to equitably reflect the variation in area production costs and may  
12 not

13 (1) when added to any federal price support payment, produce  
14 a sum in excess of 120 per cent of the production cost as previously  
15 determined by the director;

16 (2) exceed \$35 the first year nor exceed \$30 for any year  
17 thereafter;

18 (3) in 1971 exceed 80 per cent of the rate paid in that area  
19 in 1970 [1969];

20 (4) in 1972 exceed 60 per cent of the rate paid in that area  
21 in 1970 [1969];

22 (5) in 1973 exceed 40 per cent of the rate paid in that area  
23 in 1970 [1969];

24 (6) in 1974 exceed 20 per cent of the rate paid in that area  
25 in 1970 [1969];

26 (7) be paid for grain produced after 1974.

27 \* Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
