6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state parks and establishing
7 the Denali State Park."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 41.20.020(6) is amended to read:

10 (6) establish, in accordance with the Administrative
11 Procedure Act, rules and regulations governing the use and designating
12 incompatible uses within the boundaries of state park and recreational
13 areas to protect the property and to preserve the peace;

14 * Sec. 2. AS 41.20 is amended by adding new sections to read:

15 ARTICLE 5. DENALI STATE PARK.

16 Sec. 41.20.170. DECLARATION OF PURPOSE. The purpose of secs.
17 170-180 of this chapter is to restrict state owned lands and waters
18 described in sec. 180 of this chapter to use as a state park. Under
19 the provisions of AS 38.05.300 state land, water or land and water
20 containing more than 640 acres may be closed to multiple use only
21 by act of the legislature. Because the area described in sec. 180
22 of this chapter exceeds 640 acres, secs. 170-180 of this chapter are
23 intended to provide for the closing of the described lands and
24 waters to multiple use in conformity with AS 38.05.300 and their
25 designation as a special purpose area in accord with art. VIII,
26 sec. 7 of the Constitution of the State of Alaska.

27 Sec. 41.20.180. DESIGNATED STATE LANDS AND WATERS RESTRICTED
28 TO USE AS A STATE PARK. The state owned lands and waters and that
29 acquired in the future by the state lying within the parcels described

1 in this section are designated as the Denali State Park. These
2 lands and waters are reserved from all uses incompatible with their
3 primary function as park area. Lands covered by secs. 170-180 of
4 this chapter are those within the following described parcels:

5 Township 29N Range 6W, Range 5W, and that portion of Range 4W
6 lying north and west of the Alaska Railroad right-of-way, Township
7 30N Range 5W and that portion of Range 4W lying north and west of
8 the Alaska Railroad right-of-way, Township 31N Range 5W, Range 4W
9 and that portion of Range 3W and Range 2W lying north and west of
10 the Alaska Railroad right-of-way, Township 32N Range 4W, Range 3W
11 and that portion of Range 2W lying north and west of the Alaska
12 Railroad right-of-way, and Township 33N Range 4W, Range 3W and that
13 portion of Range 2W lying west of the Alaska Railroad right-of-way
14 all in the Seward Meridian; and Township 22S Range 12W Fairbanks
15 Meridian.
