6 For an Act entitled: "An Act concerning grants and loans for water supply
7 and sewerage systems."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 46.05 is amended by adding a new section to read:

10 Sec. 46.05.155. GRANTS AND LOANS FOR WATER SUPPLY AND SEWERAGE
11 SYSTEMS. (a) The department may pay, as funds are available, 25 per
12 cent of the estimated reasonable cost, as determined by the Secretary
13 of the Interior, of each waste treatment works project approved for a
14 federal grant by the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration
15 and on which construction was initiated after June 30, 1966. As funds
16 are available, the department may lend on an interest free basis for a
17 project approved after June 30, 1970, any part of an anticipated
18 federal grant. Any money received from the Federal Water Pollution
19 Control Administration for the project after the loan is given must
20 be used to repay the loan, but the loan need be repaid only to the
21 extent of such federal assistance.

22 (b) The department may pay to any municipality, as funds are
23 available, up to the lesser of 25 per cent of the estimated cost or
24 50 per cent of the estimated cost not borne by the federal government,
25 if there is federal assistance, of water systems and of those portions
26 of sewerage systems not covered by (a) of this section. The estimated
27 cost of any part of a system will be as determined by the federal
28 agency, if any, which gives the most monetary assistance, or if none,
29 by the department.
