5 A BILL

6 For an Act entitled: "An Act abolishing the Board of Fish and Game; and
7 providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 16.05.080 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 16.05.080. LIMITATION OF POWER. Nothing in this chapter
11 authorizes the department [OR THE BOARD] to change the amount of fees
12 or licenses.

13 * Sec. 2. AS 16.20.080 is amended by adding a new paragraph to read:

14 (3) "department" means the Department of Fish and Game.

15 * Sec. 3. AS 16.50.010 is repealed and re-enacted to read:

16 Sec. 16.50.010. GUIDE LICENSING AND CONTROL BOARD. There is
17 established, within the Department of Fish and Game, the Guide Licens-
18 ing and Control Board.

19 * Sec. 4. AS 16.50.420(1) is amended to read:

20 (1) "board" means the Guide Licensing and Control Board
21 [BOARD OF FISH AND GAME];

22 * Sec. 5. AS 39.05.060 is amended to read:

23 Sec. 39.05.060. APPOINTMENT, QUALIFICATIONS, AND TERMS OF OFFICE
24 OF MEMBERS OF DEPARTMENTAL BOARDS, COUNCILS, OR COMMISSIONS. Each
25 member of the Local Boundary Commission, Alcoholic Beverage Control
26 Board, Employment Security Advisory Council, Alaska State Housing
27 Authority, [BOARD OF FISH AND GAME,] and the Commission for Northern
28 Operations of Rail Transportation and Highways, shall be a citizen of
29 the United States. The governor shall appoint each member on the basis

1 of interest in public affairs, good judgment, knowledge and ability
2 in the field of action of the department for which appointed, and
3 with a view to providing diversity of interest and points of view
4 in the membership. Appointments are subject to confirmation by a
5 majority of the members of the legislature in joint session. Initial
6 appointments of members are as follows: (1) in the case of three-
7 member boards, for one, two and three years; (2) in the case of five-
8 member boards, for one, two, three, four and five years; (3) in the
9 case of six-member boards, two members serve for one year, two for two
10 years, and two for three years; (4) in the case of eight-member
11 boards, two members serve for one year, two for two years, two for
12 three years, and two for four years; (5) and in the case of 10-member
13 boards, two members serve for one year, two for two years, two for
14 three years, two for four years, and two for five years. Initial
15 terms date from February 1 before appointment. A vacancy occurring
16 during a term of office is filled in the same manner as the original
17 appointment is made and for the balance of the unexpired term. Each
18 member holds office at the pleasure of the governor notwithstanding the
19 member's term.

20 * Sec. 6. AS 44.39.030 is amended to read:

21 Sec. 44.39.030. APPOINTMENT AND TERM OF OFFICE OF COMMISSIONER.

22 The governor shall appoint the commissioner of fish and game [FROM A
23 LIST OF QUALIFIED PERSONS NOMINATED BY THE BOARD OF FISH AND GAME,
24 SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF THE GOVERNOR TO REQUEST ADDITIONAL NOMINATIONS]

25 The appointment shall be confirmed by a majority of the members of the
26 legislature in joint session. The commissioner of fish and game serves
27 for a term of five years.

28 * Sec. 7. In AS 16.05.070, AS 16.05.250 - 16.05.260, AS 16.05.800,
29 AS 16.05.820, AS 16.05.930(c), AS 16.05.940(17), AS 16.10.150(b),

1 AS 16.10.190 - 16.10.210, AS 16.20.030 - 16.20.040, AS 16.20.120, and
2 AS 16.35.200, when the word "board" appears it shall be read as "department".

3 * Sec. 8. AS 16.05.030, AS 16.05.220 - 16.05.240, AS 16.05.270 - 16.05.-
4 320, AS 16.05.940(1), AS 16.20.080(1), AS 44.39.050, and AS 44.62.330(a)(31)
5 are repealed.

6 * Sec. 9. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval
7 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
