6 For an Act entitled: "An Act providing for a supplemental allocation under
7 the Public School Foundation Program."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 14.17 is amended by adding a new section to Article 1
10 to read:

11 Sec. 14.17.077. ADDITIONAL ALLOCATION. In addition to the
12 amounts authorized to be paid to school districts under this chapter,
13 an additional allocation per pupil in total average daily membership
14 may be made to each school district. This allocation shall be equiva-
15 lent to \$10 multiplied by the number of mills property tax levied in
16 the school district in the previous year for school purposes. In those
17 districts where sales tax revenues are used for school purposes, the
18 equivalent in mills shall be determined and allocations made on that
19 basis in addition to the property tax basis.
