6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the duties of presiding superior  
7 court judges."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 22.10.130 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 22.10.130. APPOINTMENT AND DUTIES OF PRESIDING JUDGES. The  
11 chief justice of the supreme court shall designate a presiding judge  
12 for each district. The presiding judge shall in addition to his  
13 regular judicial duties (1) assign the cases pending to the judges  
14 made available within the district, (2) supervise the judges and their  
15 court personnel in the carrying out of their official duties within  
16 the district, [AND] (3) expedite and keep current the business of  
17 the court within the district, and (4) appoint a temporary district  
18 attorney in the district when a vacancy occurs, until a permanent  
19 district attorney for that district is appointed by the attorney  
20 general.
