6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to old age assistance."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 47.25.570(a) is amended to read:

9 (a) The department may require as a condition of granting finan-  
10 cial assistance that the property of a recipient, except personal  
11 property to the amount of \$500, and a recipient's personal dwelling,  
12 be pledged as a guarantee for the reimbursement of the funds granted  
13 and an instrument executed by the recipient, pledging the property,  
14 shall be made to the department and held by it for the state.

15 \* Sec. 2. AS 47.25.570(b) is amended to read:

16 (b) The state has a lien against all the property of the recipi-  
17 ent, except personal property to the amount of \$500, and a recipient's  
18 personal dwelling, in an amount equal to that expended for his benefit,  
19 from and after the filing of a claim of lien in the office of the  
20 recorder for the district in which the property is possessed or is  
21 located, particularly describing the property. Suit to foreclose the  
22 lien shall be instituted within six months after the cessation of  
23 assistance or as soon afterward as possible.

25 (c) Nothing in this section prohibits a lien in an amount equal  
26 to the total of all assistance granted the recipient from attaching to  
27 property, excluding a personal dwelling, purchased with the proceeds  
28 paid by the taking authority.
