6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to the reclassification of organized  
7 boroughs; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 \* Section 1. AS 07.35.020(b) is amended to read:

10 (b) A second class borough may reclassify as a first class or a  
11 third class borough in the same manner provided by this title for the  
12 addition of powers by a second class borough. Instead of specifying  
13 powers to be added, the petition shall request that the borough be re-  
14 classified as a first class or a third class borough. Voting on the  
15 question shall be areawide [RECLASSIFICATION AS A FIRST CLASS BOROUGH IS  
16 LIMITED TO THE QUALIFIED VOTERS RESIDING OUTSIDE CITIES WITHIN THE  
17 BOROUGH]. The third class borough assembly shall be elected at the time  
18 of voting on reclassification of the borough.

19 \* Sec. 2. AS 07.35.020(c) is amended to read:

20 (c) A third class borough may reclassify as a second class or a  
21 first class borough in the same manner provided by (b) of this section  
22 for the reclassification of a second class borough. [A SECOND CLASS  
23 BOROUGH MAY RECLASSIFY AS A THIRD CLASS OR A FIRST CLASS BOROUGH.]  
24 Voting on the question shall be areawide. The borough chairman and  
25 borough school board [THIRD CLASS BOROUGH ASSEMBLY] shall be elected at  
26 the time of voting on reclassification of the borough.

27 \* Sec. 3. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and approval  
28 or on the day it becomes law without approval.
