6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to parks and recreational
7 facilities; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 41.20 is amended by adding new sections to read:

10 ARTICLE 5. GENERAL

11 Sec. 41.20.200. PENALTY. A person who violates a provision
12 of this chapter or a regulation promulgated under this chapter is
13 guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction is punishable by a fine
14 of not more than \$1,000 or by imprisonment for not more than six
15 months or by both.

16 Sec. 41.20.210. ENFORCEMENT AUTHORITY. (a) The following
17 persons are peace officers of the state and they shall enforce the
18 provisions of this chapter and the regulations promulgated under
19 this chapter:

20 (1) an employee of the department authorized by the
21 commissioner;

22 (2) a police officer in the state;

23 (3) any other person authorized by the commissioner.

24 (b) Each person designated in (a) of this section may, when en-
25 forcing the provisions of this chapter or a regulation made under
26 this chapter:

27 (1) execute a warrant or other process issued by an officer
28 or court of competent jurisdiction;

29 (2) administer or take an oath, affirmation or affidavit;

2 (3) arrest a person who violates a provision of this
3 chapter or a regulation made under this chapter.

4 Sec. 41.20.220. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter

5 (1) "department" means the department of natural resources;

6 (2) "commissioner" means the commissioner of natural
7 resources.

8 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on the day after its passage and
9 approval or on the day it becomes law without approval.
