6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to sabbatical leave for teachers."

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

8 \* Section 1. AS 14.20.280 is amended to read:

9       Sec. 14.20.280. BASIS OF LEAVE. A teacher who has rendered  
10 active service for six [SEVEN] or more years in the state [A DISTRICT]  
11 is eligible for sabbatical leave. Sabbatical leave may be taken for  
12 educational purposes only, and for not more than one school year.
