6 For an Act entitled: "An Act relating to state employees' military leaves
7 of absence; and providing for an effective date."

8 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

9 * Section 1. AS 39.20.340 is amended to read:

10 Sec. 39.20.340. LEAVE OF ABSENCE FOR RESERVE MEMBERS OF ARMED
11 FORCES. (a) An [OFFICIAL OR] employee of the state, or a political
12 subdivision, [OR A MUNICIPAL CORPORATION] with the approval of the city
13 council or borough assembly, who is a member of a reserve component
14 of the United States Armed Forces is entitled to a leave of absence
15 without loss of pay, time, or efficiency rating on all days during
16 which he is ordered to training duty, as distinguished from active
17 duty, with troops or at field exercises, or for instruction. The
18 leave of absence may not exceed 16 1/2 working days in any one
19 calendar year.

20 (b) If an employee is called to active duty by the governor,
21 an employee otherwise qualified in (a) of this section is entitled
22 to five days leave of absence without loss of pay, time, or efficiency
23 rating.

24 * Sec. 2. This Act takes effect on July 1, 1970.
